Used in Michelin starred kitchens, including the Pipe and Glass at South Dalton, all Yorkshire Rapeseed Oil products are preservative, GM and gluten-free, and are suitable for vegetarians.

Their oil contains only half the saturated fat and 11 times the omega 3 of olive oil.
