


### **Welcome to our Summer Market**

### Help take nature's pulse!

Claire and Bertie of Butterflies Chocolate are supporting the Butterfly Conservation's annual Big Butterfly Count. Claire will donate 5% of the sales from market stalls during this period and you'll be able to collect a butterfly chart from the Butterflies Chocolate Hovingham Market stall in July and August.

#### What is it?

The Big Butterfly Count is the world's largest butterfly survey, which encourages people to spot and record 18 species of common butterflies and two day-flying moths during three weeks of high summer.

More than three-quarters of the UK's butterflies have declined in the last 40 years with some common species, such as the Small Tortoiseshell, suffering significant slumps. This year's Count follows findings that butterflies are declining more rapidly in urban areas than in the countryside.

#### When is it?

The Count runs from 20 July to 12 August.

#### How do I get involved?

Taking part in the Count is easy - find a sunny spot and spend 15 minutes counting the butterflies you see and then submit sightings online at <a href="https://www.bigbutterflycount.org">www.bigbutterflycount.org</a> or via the free Big Butterfly Count app.
