


A very BIG thank you to all our visitors, stallholders, volunteers, local partners and community for supporting 10 years of the Hovingham Village Market.

Together we've made this happen. We've a few surprises to delight and surprise, so come along and be part of this momentous occasion.









F&B International - handmade home décor made in country prints and tweed




Westow Vineyard is a small vineyard owned and established by the Mason family, producing sparkling wines.



Woodwrym - delightful wooden spoons



















Nunnington Galleries showcases the work of a carefully selected group of contemporary artists working in a range of media to convey their love of the North Yorkshire landscape and its wildlife.













